Inventory tracking on all Epicor building supply solutions is done through barcodes and handheld barcode scanners. These updated scanners replace traditional manual data entry in areas like:


Receiving

With handheld scanners, you're not paying someone to sit at a computer and transfer data by hand from a sheet of paper into your business system. Recording the information now occurs out on the warehouse floor, or in the yard by your operations personnel as they go about their everyday jobs. Most important, data entry errors are virtually eliminated with barcode scanning—as are mundane data entry and paper filing jobs.





Benefit #3—True Inventory Accuracy

Calculating inventory accuracy using total dollar value allows the inventory surpluses to cancel out the shortages. This results in a lower net discrepancy that doesn't reflect the "true" level of inventory accuracy. Epicor solutions can help you get a clearer, cleaner result.

Our definition of "true" inventory accuracy means the right product, in the right quantity, in the right location. To determine your true inventory accuracy, simply do the following:

- Look at your latest physical inventory variance reports, or randomly sample 50-100 items in your warehouse

- Compare what your computer system thinks you have in a given location to what is actually there

Companies that calculate a 95% dollar-value accuracy may find that their warehouses actually have only 40–60% true accuracy—when spread throughout a warehouse, these variances can cost companies significant time and money.

How Inventory Inaccuracies Kill Warehouse Efficiency

Most of the issues that your employees deal with on a day-to-day basis are due to inventory discrepancies and lack of inventory visibility. Do these issues sound familiar? Frequent sales rep calls to the warehouse to check on stock

- Incorrect shipments due to the wrong product in the wrong location
- Missed sales because you don't have accurate stock information on hand
- Customers that were promised stock up front, but don't end up getting it because there isn't enough on hand
- Non-stock items that are ordered and rush-shipped to customers, only to discover you already had the items tucked away in the warehouse
- Countless hours spent trying to find missing or misplaced products






